SUBJECT: CUT OFF DATES FOR 2013/2014 FINANCIAL YEAR END

1 PURPOSE

The purpose of this circular is to advise Departments on cut-off dates for transactions to be completed in order to have a smooth financial year end closure.

2 BACKGROUND

Every financial year end Departments experience challenges on closing the financial Year End on BAS system, in the event that National Treasury implements a force closure. This is a bad reflection on the management of the system and finance. The Provincial Treasury therefore has decided in the previous years to set up cut-off dates at which the current year transactions must be finalised for the year.

3 DISCUSSION

Herewith are cut-off dates and activities to be followed for the financial year 2013/14. Departments are therefore advised to adhere to the dates to enable a smooth Year End closure. Failure to comply will result in departments being force closed. Please be further advised that the Provincial Treasury will be available for assistance in the event of challenges experienced by Departments. It is also important that the process flow be observed.

14 March 2014	Departments to process Commitment already on the system as from 14th Marc 2014
	Departments to stop the <u>Creation of new Commitments</u> by not doing <u>PAAI</u> (Procurement Advice Approval) as this will result in the creation of new Commitments
	The <u>Processing</u> of new orders (i.e from <u>Commitment</u> to <u>Order Final</u>) must be stopped if the <u>Final Payment</u> may go beyond 25 March 2014 (Last day of payment) otherwise they must be decommitted.
7 March 2014 – 21 March 2014	Departments to focus on paying all outstanding and current invoices during this period
	Departments are urged to follow up outstanding invoices with suppliers for work that has been done.
March 2014	25 March 2014 is the last day of payments and no payment or Order Final must be processed on this date.
