EMPOWERMENT OF CO-OPERATIVES AND COMPANIES OWNED BY PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES WHEN PROCURING GOODS, SERVICES AND WORKS IN LINE WITH THE PREFERENTIAL PROCUREMENT REGULATIONS, 2017

### PURPOSE

The purpose of this circular is to remind Accounting Officers of Municipalities and Municipal Entities about the implementation of the Preferential Procurement Regulations of 2017.

## 2. BACKGROUND

The Office of the Chief Procurement Officer in the National Treasury has published the revised Preferential Procurement Regulations in terms of section 5 of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, 2000 (Act no.5 of 2000) (PPPFA) wherein all organs of state are to utilize the revised Act with effect from 1 April 2017.

### 3. DISCUSSION

The new Preferential Procurement Regulations of 2017 are influenced to a greater extent compared to the previous one by the determination to provide a socio-economic transformation mechanism that will assist in targeting and promoting certain categories of groups, including Exempted Micro Enterprises (EMEs) and Qualifying Small Enterprise (QSE) which is owned by 51% blacks, women, youth, military veterans, people with disabilities, cooperatives and black people living in rural or underdeveloped areas and / or townships.

# 4. PROVINCIAL TREASURY'S DIRECTIVE

Part of our mandate is to oversee and monitor the processes that are followed by public sector institutions in procuring goods, works and services in the Province. However in addition you are requested to also prioritise the empowerment of **co-operatives and companies owned by disabled people** when procuring goods, services and works.

All municipalities will be required to report on the empowerment of all the designated groups in line with the new Preferential Procurement Regulations of 2017. Attached is a reporting template for this purpose.

## **DISSEMINATION OF INFORMATION**

Municipal Managers are requested to bring the contents of this Circular to the attention of the Chief Financial Officers and Heads of Supply Chain Management units for implementation in order to enhance compliance.
