TREASURY CIRCULAR NO 57 ON REPORTING ON COMPLIANCE TO THE BROAD BASED BLACK ECONOMIC EMPOWERMENT ACT, 2013 (ACT NO. 46 OF 2013)

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1. This circular serves to remind all Heads of Department and Chief Executive Officers on the need to comply with the Broad Based Black Economic Empowerment Act, 2013 (Act No. 46 of 2013).

2. BACKGROUND

2.1. The Department of Trade and Industry has in 2013 issued the revised Broad Based Black Economic Empowerment Act (BBBEEA) with the objective of promoting the economic empowerment of all black people in particular women, workers, youth, people with disabilities and people living in rural areas through diverse socio-economic strategies.

3. DISCUSSION

- 3.1.1. In the light of the above, the Provincial Treasury would like to request Heads of Department and Chief Executive Officers to, as determined by the Department of Economic Development and Tourism comply with the reporting requirements on the implementation of the Broad Based Black Economic Empowerment Act.
- 3.1.2. This will further enhance the Province's compliance with reporting requirements as determined by the Department of Trade and Industry.
