PROVINCIAL LEGISLATURE PASSES R70.3 BILLION APPROPRIATION BILL.

The Mpumalanga Provincial Treasury welcomes the passing of the Mpumalanga Appropriation Bill, 2026, by the Mpumalanga Provincial Legislature on Tuesday, 30 June 2026.

This milestone marks a critical step in the Province's budget implementation process. It enables the full execution of provincial priorities and commitments outlined by Premier Mandla Ndlovu and Members of the Executive Council during their Budget Vote speeches earlier this month.

Speaking following the adoption of the Bill, MEC Bonakele Majuba expressed appreciation to the Portfolio Committee on Finance and Members of the Provincial Legislature for their constructive engagement throughout the budget process, and for their support in ensuring the approval of the legislation.
