PROVINCIAL TREASURY REPEATS 100% QUARTER TARGET PERFORMANCE

The Mpumalanga Provincial Treasury appeared before the Portfolio Committee on Finance on Thursday, 12 March 2026, to present its third-quarter performance results and provide an update on the implementation of House resolutions.

Introducing the institution's reports, the MEC for Finance, Mr Bonakele Majuba, emphasised the department's mandate and its alignment with the committee's aspirations to build responsive and accountable state institutions.

The department reported a 100 per cent achievement of all targets for the quarter within the reporting timeframe. The institution also succeeded in implementing the resolutions of the previous quarter, including providing status reports on the procurement of the Infrastructure Delivery Management System (IDMS), payments on information and communication technology, and fleet management, amongst others.

MEC Majuba further highlighted a positive shift in local government audit outcomes.

“While the improvement in the recent audit outcomes of municipalities is encouraging, this was sufficient to drastically change the overall picture in the recent audit cycle. We will continue to push for stronger compliance and governance at the municipal level,” said MEC Majuba.

The Provincial Treasury reaffirmed its commitment to supporting all departments, public entities, and municipalities to ensure ongoing improvements in financial administration and governance.

“We will continue to deploy every mechanism within our mandate to strengthen financial management and governance where it matters most,” Head Official, Ms Gugu Mashiteng assured the committee.

The Portfolio Committee welcomed both reports, commending the department's progress in implementing House resolutions and its consistent performance.

“This is the kind of accountability and performance we expect from a key institution like the Treasury,” remarked Hon Cathy Dlamini, the chairperson of the committee.
