SAIPA PROGRAMME TO PROFESSIONALISE FINANCE PERSONNEL

BACKGROUND

The Provincial Treasury has arranged a skills development Programme for the purpose of the Chief Financial Officers (CFOs) and related qualifying finance officials in the Province to become professional Public Accountants. The Programme is arranged with the South African Institute of Public Accountants (SAIPA) and was shared with the CFOs during the Provincial Chief Financial Officer's forum.

SAIPA is the member of International Federation of Accountants (IFAC) and also that of Pan African Federation of Accountants (PAFA).

2. PROGRAMME

The Institute requires a minimum of 25 officials per semester for the classes to run in the Province. For this purpose, we therefore request the Accounting Officers to allow at least two officials to be nominated for the Programme; which will start in July 2019. Each attendee should have 16 days of class learning. The Programme will take place in Mbombela, thus, there will be minimal traveling costs and the classes are arranged as per the below schedule:

Finance and Accounting Services Sector Education and Training Authority (FASSET) funds Black Africans nationally and Black Coloureds in the Western and Eastern Cape. Candidates who do not meet the requirements will be expected to pay the tuition fee of R5,000.00 per cohort.
